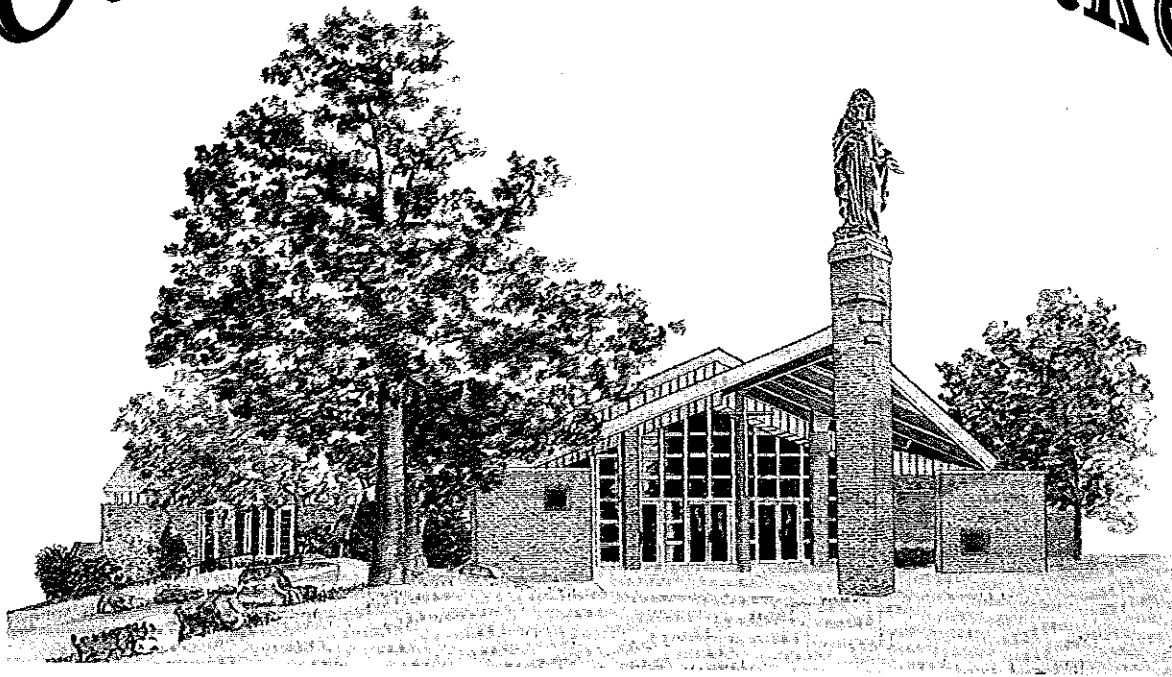

Parish Council Meeting Minutes  
January 26, 2012

Msgr. Wilbers opened the meeting with a prayer.

The meeting then proceeded with the election of the new officers for 2012. Arnold Sandbothe was elected President; Gary Kelly, Vice President; and Karen Blevins, Secretary.

**Minutes** from the December 15, 2011 meeting were read and approved as recorded.

**Administration Commission:** Mr. Cassmeyer reported the parking lot overlay was completed and paid for in full. Cassmeyer mentioned the completion for the sanctuary renovations was slated for Feb. 26. Next for the Administration Commission is what to do with the maintenance of the landscaping; looking over bids at the February 16 meeting. There are plans in place to recycle the old lights that surrounded the church's perimeter. A suggestion was made to consider placing large colorful flowerpots outside the front of the church for the upcoming spring/summer season.

**Finance:** Charles Cassmeyer shared the envelope collections for the past six months ending December 31<sup>st</sup> are less than budgeted while the loose collection is more than budgeted. The total for the two collections are \$575.00 less than budgeted. Expenses are \$1841.00 less than budgeted. Capital expenses for the six month period are \$133,292.00. The greatest portion of this was for the parking lot overlay (not included in the budget) and the railings.

**Worship and Spiritual Development Commission:** Msgr. Wilbers talked briefly about the upcoming Lenten season. Material for Lent has been selected and ordered. Ash Wednesday services are Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Education Commission:** Msgr. Wilbers reported for Sister Joanne. He reassured us that the Confirmation classes and PSR classes are continuing with the assistance of church volunteers. *Why Catholic* Sessions 7-12 will begin on Feb. 15.

**Social Concerns:** No report.

**Old Business:** On Feb. 26 Msgr. Wilbers will be celebrating his 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a priest with a special Mass at 10:00 a.m. and a reception afterward.

**New Business:** It was recommended that a new pictorial directory be considered.

The meeting closed at 6:45 p.m. with a prayer.

## Lenten Regulations 2012

As another Lenten journey of conversion begins on **Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2012** and ends with Mass of the Lord's Supper on **Holy Thursday, April 5, 2012**, Holy Mother Church calls all Catholics to a deeper spirit of penance, fasting, almsgiving and prayer, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God and to others" (Catechism of the Catholic Church #1434 & 1969). In order to foster a greater spirit of penance, of reparation for sin, to encourage self denial, and to guide us more closely in the footsteps of Christ Holy Mother Church reminds of the following **obligations of fast and abstinence** during Lent and also **admonishes us all to deeper prayer and worship**.

**Abstinence**— Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. **Fast**— Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

**Exempt from Fasting and abstinence regulations:** pregnant and/or nursing women, manual laborers engaged in heavy, strenuous work, people who are sick and/or frail, as well as military personnel deployed or in hostile environments. People in doubt regarding fasting and abstinence should consult their parish priest or pastoral administrator. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
