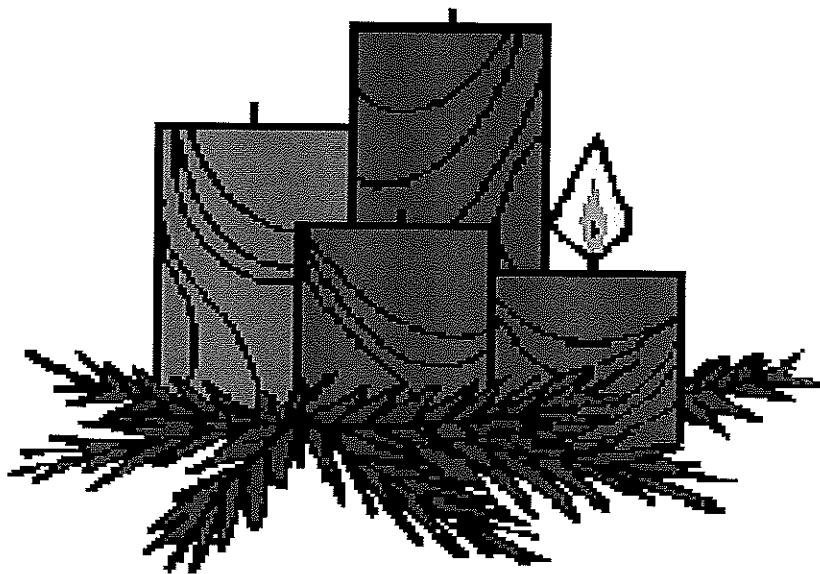

Our parish goal this year is \$16,547.00

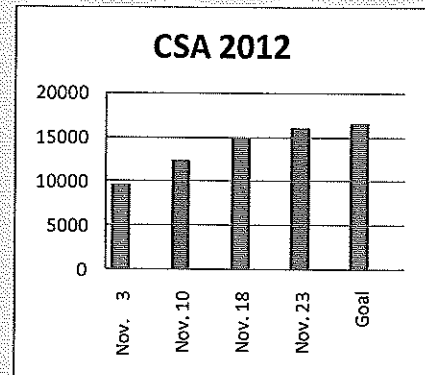
So far our parish has donated \$16,050.00 towards our goal.
