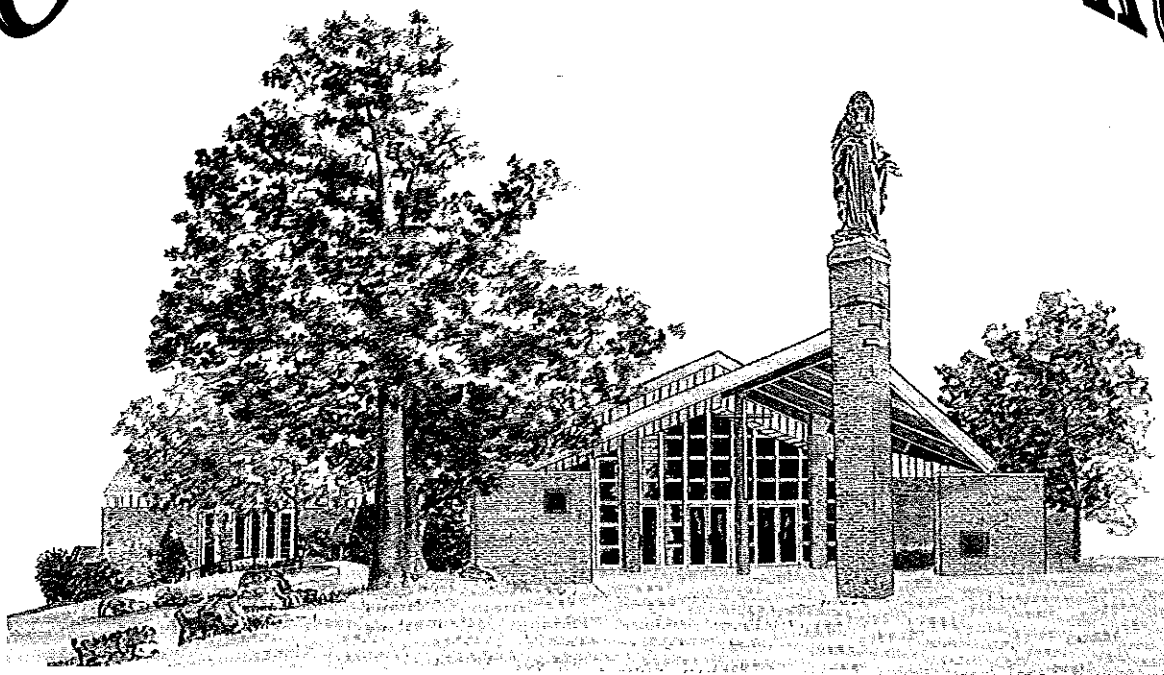

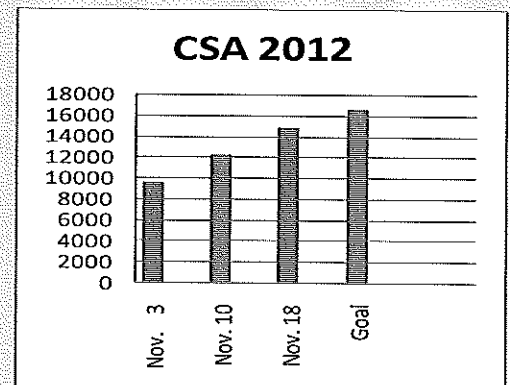
Our parish goal this year is \$16,547.00
